Brennley Brown is a 15 year old, country singer-songwriter and finalist on Season 12 of The Voice. The sheer purity, power, and control of her voice, combined with her emotive performances leave a lasting impression on all who hear the young performer, who was raised on classic country music from the likes of Willie Nelson and Dolly Parton. With the guidance of coach Gwen Stefani, who stole her from her original coach Blake Shelton, Brown became the longest charting minor in the show's history with her rendition of "Up To The Mountain" in the Knockout Round. She continues on the path to the live shows - no doubt continuing to stun the North American viewing audience along the way. Brown holds an Ovation Award, voices characters on Nickelodeon, Disney and DreamWorks and has performed for sold-out crowds across the country.
